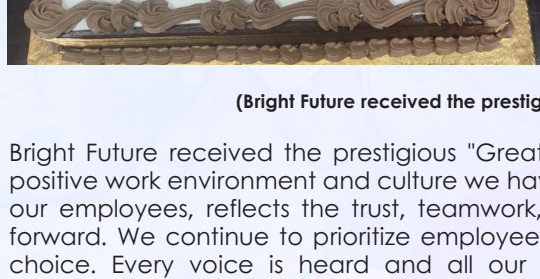




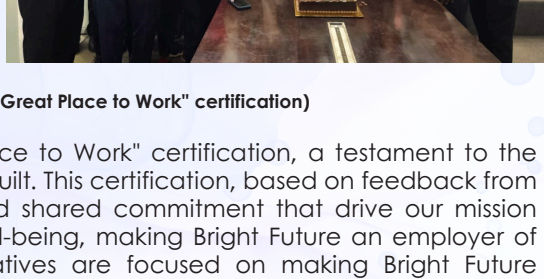
Highlights

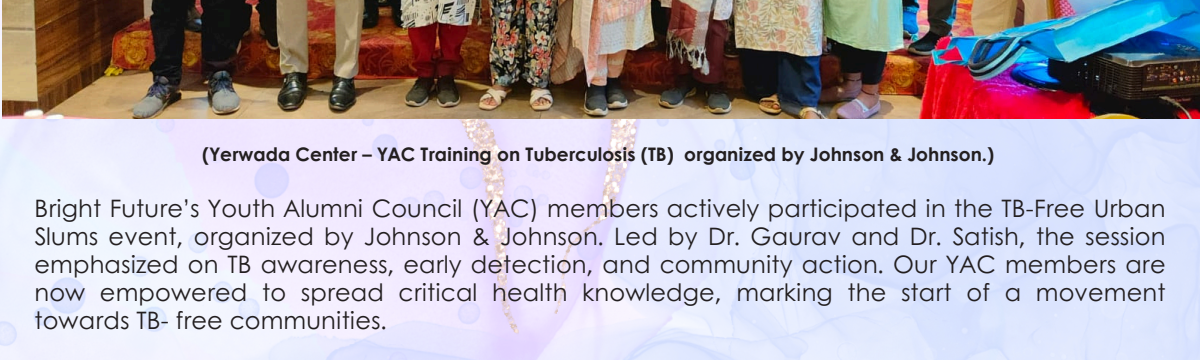
(First Podcast Zameeni Haqeeqat: First Step, First Story!)

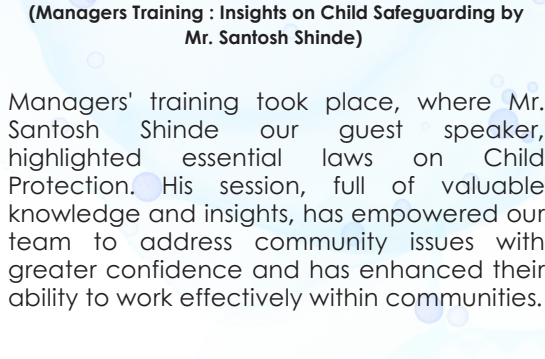
(Yerwada Center – YAC Training on Tuberculosis (TB) organized by Johnson & Johnson.)

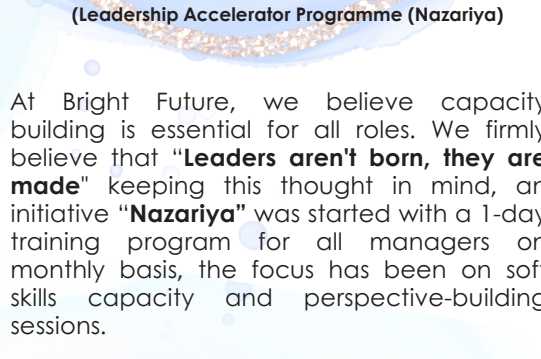

(Managers Training : Insights on Child Safeguarding by Mr. Santosh Shinde)






(Leadership Accelerator Programme (Nazariya))
