Holding Space for Change: 44 Facilitators, One Powerful Pehchan

For the first time ever, 44 dedicated Bright Future facilitators from Delhi, Ahmedabad, Mumbai, Pune, Hyderabad, and Bengaluru came together for a powerful three-day residential 'Pehchan' training an experience designed to strengthen their sense of purpose, sharpen their skills, and deepen their alignment with the Bright Future Skill Framework.



But this was more than just training. It was a much-needed space to pause, reflect, realign and rise even higher.

Over three transformative days, our facilitators:

- Shifted mindsets from teaching to facilitation.
- Applied youth protection principles to real-life scenarios.
- Help build confidence through practical sessions and constructive peer feedback.



At just 20, Tauqeer Shaikh sat quietly in the corner of his classroom - shy, withdrawn, torn between studies, work, and family duties. Financial struggles often forced him to leave class early, and his lack of confidence held him back from even trying.

Everything changed the day a facilitator told him, "I don't like hearing no. Everyone should at least try." Tauqeer hesitated, but he did try and he won. That moment flipped a switch: "In life, we lose more by not trying than by trying and failing."

Encouraged by this, Tauqeer found his voice. His favorite subject, Creative Thinking, helped him express himself and build skills like Communication and Collaboration skills he never thought he'd master. Today, Tauqeer works as a Sales Executive at Bayleaf, earning ₹21,000 a month. From a silent observer to a confident professional, his journey shows what one chance and the courage to take it can do.
