They were introduced to Bright Future's various free programs, including life skills development, mentorship, and industry exposure opportunities.

The session also aimed to debunk myths around career success and emphasized the importance of following one's passion with a practical mindset. Students left the session feeling inspired and equipped with actionable steps toward planning their futures more intentionally.
